DECLARATION REGARDING EARTHQUAKE DAMAGE

I/ We declare as a material fact that the home, home contents or commercial property to be insured has suffered no damage in the 4th September 2010 Canterbury earthquake and/or any of the subsequent aftershocks (altogether referred to as the Canterbury earthquake).

In the case of contents only insurance, I/We declare as a material fact that the building in which the contents are located has suffered no damage in the Canterbury earthquake.

I/We declare that there is no known physical damage to land and/or property in the immediate vicinity of the property to be insured, that has arisen out of the Canterbury earthquake that may result in damage to the property to be insured.

After I/We have made this declaration, if I/We become aware of any earthquake damage as described in any of the statements above, I/We agree to notify the insurer immediately.

THE EFFECT OF THIS DECLARATION

A material fact is one that would have led the insurer to make different decisions about either:

- i) accepting this insurance, and/or
- ii) setting the terms for this insurance.

If I/We have misrepresented this information the insurer may without limitation:

- i) declare this policy unenforceable, or
- ii) decline any subsequent claim either in whole or in part.

This declaration is a supporting statement to the insurance application dealing solely with the Canterbury Earthquake. It forms part of the policy and is in addition to any other declarations and/or information provided to the insurer as part of the insurance application.
